CPI(ML) flags errors in draft rolls; EC says no objections filed in first 24 hrs

Patna/New Delhi: Even as the Election Commission of India (ECI) claimed on Saturday that not a single claim or objection had been filed within the first 24 hours of publishing Bihar's draft electoral rolls, the CPI(ML) claimed it had submitted an objection letter via email regarding names of living voters being listed as dead. The ECI had released the draft rolls on Friday and issued its first daily status update on Saturday.

While the EC maintained that none of the 1.6 lakh booth-level agents (BLAs) deployed by a dozen political parties filed any official objections by 3pm on Aug 2, CPI(ML) state secretary Kunal alleged irregularities in the special intensive revision (SIR) exercise. He submitted proof of two such voters — Kudrat Khan and Shalesh Prasad — from Bhore assembly constituency whose names, he claimed, had been wrongly included in the list of deceased voters. "At booth number 339, Sisa village, the names of people who are alive have been declared dead. Meanwhile,

five names earlier listed as dead at booth number 317 have now been re-included, but two remain missing," Kunal said. He demanded assembly-wise and booth-wise details of the 65,64,075 voters deleted in the first phase of the SIR.

Vikasheel Insaan Party (VIP) chief Mukesh Sahani alleged, "My wife lives in Mumbai, but her name has been added here. The ECI is working for the BJP. Democracy is in danger. Every citizen should think about this. We will take to the streets over this issue."

However, the EC reiterated that all parties had agreed to review the boothwise rolls and yet "no BLA of any political party has submitted a single case to BLOs during the first 24 hours."

The EC said it had already received 3,223 applications for fresh enrolment by first-time voters and was running awareness campaigns. Special camps will be held daily at block and urban offices till Sept 1.

Eligible voters are urged to verify their names and submit photographs for new voter cards.

BJP, JD(U) slam Tejawhi over name removal claim

Whereas the ECI has repeatedly reiterated that the voter serial number and booth serial number of those whose names are in the released format may be different, no change has been made in the EPIC number. Not only this, in the released format, it has been asked to check through the EPIC number — whether your name is in the format or not. There is no provision for changing the EPIC number. And if it was changed, then why was he not informed," Gagan said.

Tejawhi, too, raised questions about the voter deletion process. He claimed that 20,000 to 30,000 names had been removed from nearly every assembly constituency and that approximately 65 lakh names had been deleted across the state. "First of all, the EPIC number does not change. How did it change," Tejawhi asked after the Patna DM released the electoral list bearing his name and serial number.

Following the ECI's clarifi-

fication, senior BJP politician and deputy CM Samrat Choudhary attacked the RJD politician.

"Tejawhi-ji, not only I but your family and the whole of Bihar have doubts about your ability. It must be very difficult for you to find your name in the SIR draft. Your name is respectfully registered with your father at number 416, you can see it. Now stop this misleading and fraudulent business. RJD's confusion and fear are proving to be bogus again and again," he said.

JD(U) state president Umesh Singh Kushwahala also criticised Tejawhi.

Commending the efforts of its electoral machinery, the commission said pure electoral rolls are the bedrock of democracy and credited EROs, AEROs, BLO supervisors and BLOs for playing "a pivotal role in the preparation of impartial and transparent rolls". The new honorarium structure, which comes into effect immediately, will apply across the country. The voter list revision campaign, which began in Bihar, will subsequently be carried

out in other states.

The enhanced compensation came amid heightened political criticism of the commission. On Friday, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi accused the EC of "vote chori" (vote theft) during the Lok Sabha elections in Karnataka and threatened to release an "atom bomb" of evidence. The EC, however, has chosen not to respond directly. Instead, it reiterated its faith in the integrity of its poll staff and advised them to ignore such remarks and continue performing their duties.

Some political parties trying to mislead people on SIR, says Rajnath

Criticising opposition parties, Rajnath said the special intensive revision (SIR) of the electoral rolls in Bihar was not a new process and that the ECI has carried out similar exercises across the country in the past. "But some political parties are trying to mislead the public on SIR," he said.

Taking the opposition to task, he said the whole world is aware of the indecisive stance taken by the Congress and certain other parties on issues related to terrorism. "If we remember the atmosphere of insecurity in the country before 2014, even today, people shudder. Bomb blasts used to take place in the country every day. Instead of congratulating the army, the opposition started questioning the achievements of the army," he said. He also recalled the serial blasts in Patna's Gandhi Maidan.

Taking another dig at the opposition, Singh said Bihar is at a crossroads. "Two paths lead from here — one towards development, on which the golden future of Bihar depends, and the other that will push Bihar back into an era of crime and anarchy from which the state has emerged

with great difficulty," he said.

He added that just as eastern countries have become engines of global development, eastern states including Bihar will play a similar role in building a developed India. "I believe that the same Bihar, which the world once looked at with disdain, can today become an inspiration," he said.

Patna: Police have arrested a 19-year-old youth and his friend in connection with the murder of two siblings whose charred bodies were found at their home in Nagwan village under the Janipur police station area of Patna district.

The arrested youths have been identified as Shubham Kumar alias Sunny and his associate, Roshan Kumar (19), a resident of Pulla Toia.

Patna SSP Kartikeya K Sharma on Saturday said the murders were driven by jealousy and a failed relationship between the girl, Anjali Kumari (14), and the prime accused. "Both were friends since school days. The families were aware of their relationship, which continued for about one to two years. However, their families

2 die of asphyxiation in M'pura septic tank

Madhepura: Two workers died of asphyxiation and two others were rendered unconscious after they entered a recently cast septic tank for de-shuttering work in Madhepura's Singheshwar town on Saturday.

The victims were identified as Yogendra Yadav, 54, a resident of Lalpatti Sukhan village, and Dipi Chauhan, 45, from Budhabe village. The two unconscious workers were rescued by the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) personnel and taken to Jannayak Karpoori Thakur Medical College and Hospital for treatment.

According to police, a local resident had engaged the four workers to carry out the de-shuttering of the newly constructed septic tank. "All four entered the tank one after another and fell unconscious due to toxic gases trapped inside," an officer said.

When the house owner saw what had happened, he raised an alarm and alerted the local SDRF unit. "Two of the workers were already dead when we pulled them out. The other two were unconscious and were rushed to the hospital," said an SDRF official.

Singheshwar SHO Bindendra Ram said, "The bodies were taken to Madhepura Sadar Hospital for autopsy," police said.

Woman dies by suicide in Bettiah

Patna: A 28-year-old married woman died by suicide after her alleged obscene video went viral in Bettiah on Saturday. Before taking the extreme step, the victim made a video accusing a youth of ruining her life.

According to police, her
